In you email, please include your mailing address, where you would like to coach (school or area), if you have a preference between our Girls on the Run or Girls on Track programs, and any other info that you think would be helpful for us to know.

We will email you and mail out an Information Packet.

In the packet is information about the program and its administration, a sample lesson, coach applications, a site application (if applicable) and a DVD.

Please note that everyone involved with the program must complete a Coach Application.

Once we receive your paperwork, we process it.

We review the coach applications and site application, do a background check, create a file for you, and add you to our email distribution list. You will be notified when your application is complete and approved.

If you will be joining an existing site, we'll contact the coaches in your area or at the school you'd like to be at to see if they can incorporate you into their coach team.
